1. АННОТАЦИЯ ДИСЦИПЛИНЫ

Actually, are you alright? Do you plan to fall in love, to marry someone (eventually) – who is the same normal, like it should be, an ordinary person, man or woman? Would you rather prefer someone else – a villain, mythical dragon or almighty God? If not, to what extent would you like to balance your 'normality' with some extraordinary spice – and what is it like to be, dating a different one?

The concept of weird, special, different – sometimes an object, a metaphor – received numerous names and meanings in wide-ranging fields of arts and humanities from philosophy (inevitable Foucault) to literature and music. The strange, non-conventional approaches in love ("strange love" @Depeche Mode), love-and-hate relationship, the unnatural unities between people and the creatures of the underworld – from vampires and Elven princesses to aliens or AI – have already become a canon in popular culture, exploiting this topic to the extent that it itself appears to be not different anymore. Still, is there nothing left for us?

Haven't we ever felt something strange with love, or loved someone on a distance, or differently (sharing it between say your dad, your Motherland, your favorite cookies, your precious college); so what is another love? And why there has to be music?

The course is focused on a selection of hallmark music compositions (famous operas) and several books and films exemplifying this ungraspable and non-definable subject of another love. These compositions have never been yet taught at SAS. The course is aimed at everybody with ears to hear, mind to read (and, yes, a black heart to love) interested in classical and sometimes rock music, intertwined for a change with some alternative art examples.

Topic 1. What love is? And what love isn't?

Othering love. What love is? And what love isn't? Where is the end when love becomes weird; and how to differentiate good from bad? The first bad girl in an opera & Watching and discussing George Bizet's Carmen.

Topic 2. Bad girls. How come?

Bad girls are also in Russian nineteenth-centuries opera. How come? Discussing and watching Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov's Tsar's Bride. Imagine your own drama... What would be your good or bad girls? How would you create a conflict with strange love involved?

Topic 3. Love for and NOT for sale.

Giuseppe Verdi's La Traviata & Giacomo Puccini's La Bohème. Imagine your afterlove.

Topic 4. A truly evil love.

Alban Berg's Lulu. How horrible your love can be? Analyzing negation in love.

Topic 5. How free is free love?

Lulu found in the USSR: Dmitri Shostakovich's Lady Macbeth of Mtsensk District. Watching & discussing the opera. Engaging into Soviet Eros: how free is free love? Andrei Zamyatin's We, the concepts of collectivism; erotic and sexual deviations of early Soviet culture. Reading: Zolotonosov, Igor Kon. Love against/ for labor: love to work – work is love.

Platonov and Eisenstein in search for Love-and-Labor concepts.

Topic 6. LaL concept in Soviet films.

Sergei Yutkevich's Counterplan, Ivan Pyriev's movies (Kuban Cossacks), other films. Love (sometimes) against Soviet spirit. Analyzing and discussing Soviet cinematic (Tarkovsky's) and music (by Aquarium, Leningrad, others) compositions. Reading: Tsuker, no words. The strangest sensation: constructing your own 'another love'. Group workshop.

Topic 7. Love with the other.

Aliens, robots, mutants, insects... Love with the other. Is our (post) future bringing us more entities to differentiate our menu? Are you with love with your car or phone already?

4.1 Текущий контроль

Оценка за курс складывается из следующих видов заданий текущего контроля: READING and VIEWING QUIZZES - 25% of final grade

A close reading of the mandatory texts and an attentive viewing of the assigned audiovisual materials is required each week. Students are expected to annotate the texts and take notes while viewing the audiovisual materials.

To increase your familiarity and confidence with the material, you will complete daily quizzes (or brief, informal tests) based on the readings for the course.

CLASS PARTICIPATION - 25% of final grade

During each class, specific sections of the assigned readings and viewings will be discussed. Students are expected to engage in a meaningful conversation, by contributing thoughts and questions on the course materials. In addition to the assigned course materials, students are also expected to acquire basic information on the topics listed in the syllabus prior to each class. STUDENTS' ESSAY - 50% of final grade

4.2 Промежуточная аттестация

The examination will consist of a 90-minute written test that includes the identification of ten quotations from required course readings and a written essay. The use of any electronic devices is prohibited. The student must: 1) Attribute the given quotations; identify the sections of the texts (such as a chapter) where the quotations are taken from as well as their authors, titles, and year of publication. 2) Based on the given quotations, write an essay in English (1000–1500 words) analyzing semantic relationships between the texts where these quotations are taken from.
